Mr Todd Harper will lead a seminar featuring Dr Kami Pothukuchi & Professor Rob Moodie discussing the role for Planners in community and regional food systems.

Todd commenced as the CEO of VicHealth in April 2007 after spending many years in tobacco control and health promotion in both Victoria and Tasmania. He has a degree in economics, a postgraduate diploma in health promotion and a graduate diploma in health economics.

Kami is Associate Professor of Urban Planning at Wayne State University, USA. Her research examines the links between food and the health of communities, and the roles public and not for profit agencies might play to foster these links. Dr Pothukuchi has written and spoken extensively concerning the contributions of urban agriculture to neighbourhood health, efforts to attract grocery supermarkets to underserved communities, community food assessments, and roles of urban planning agencies in building more sustainable food systems. She recently co-authored a policy guide on community and regional food planning which was formally adopted by the American Planning Association. She is also an active volunteer with grassroots and national organisations to foster community food security.

Rob is Professor of Global Health at the Nossal Institute for Global Health at Melbourne University. Dr Moodie has an interest in the connection between planning and health and has recently been appointed Chair of the Melbourne 2030 Audit Expert Group. Dr Moodie is the former CEO of VicHealth and has almost 30 years experience in multi-disciplinary public policy roles.
